WEEK 2

MONDAY: ZEAL

BIBLE STORY: Apollos Shows Great Zeal (Acts 18:24-28)

- How did the man possessed of demons show his zeal? (Luke 8:39)
- What does Paul instruct us to do with our zeal? (Romans 12:11)

TUESDAY: CONFESSION

BIBLE STORY: The Prodigal Son Confesses His Sin (Luke 15:11-32)

- What has God given us through his mercy? (1 Peter 1:3,4)

FRIDAY'S PSALM: Read PSALM 23. Which verse is your favorite?

WEEK 3

MONDAY: COMPASSION

BIBLE STORY: God Has Compassion on His Children as They Leave Egypt (Exodus 3:7-10)

- Who set the ideal example as a compassionate person? (Matthew 20:34)
- How much compassion does God have? (Psalm 119:156)
- What is all included in God's compassion? (Psalm 145:9)

TUESDAY: OFFERINGS

BIBLE STORY: The Widow's Offering (Mark 12:41-44)

- According to what should our gifts be given to God? (Deuteronomy 16:17)
- What should be our attitude toward giving? (2 Corinthians 9:7)
- What about our frequency of giving? (1 Corinthians 16:2)

WEDNESDAY'S FAMOUS CHAPTER: Read John 10. This is often called the Good Shepherd chapter. Can you tell why?

THURSDAY: CHILDREN

BIBLE STORY: The Birth of Samuel is a Great Blessing (1 Samuel 1:1-22)

- How does Jesus feel toward children? (Mark 10:16)
- How does God look upon those who have children? (Psalm 127:3-5)
- What command does God give to parents? (Deuteronomy 31:12,13)

FRIDAY'S PSALM: Read PSALM 93. How mighty is the Lord God?

WEEK 4

MONDAY: CROWN

BIBLE STORY: Jesus Is Crowned with Glory (Hebrews 2:5-9)

- Who will finally receive the crown of righteousness? (2 Timothy 4:8)
- What must we do to receive the crown? (James 1:12)

- How long must we remain faithful? (Revelations 2:10b)

TUESDAY: TRINITY BIBLE STORY: The Trinity Is Present at the Creation (Genesis 1:1-3,26 and John 1:14)

- In whose name do we baptize? (Matthew 28:20)
- How is the Trinity mentioned here? (John 14:26)
- What three attributes did Paul give to the members of the Trinity? (2 Corinthians 13:14)

WEDNESDAY'S FAMOUS CHAPTER: Read Ecclesiastes 3. Perhaps you've heard this song. It tells of God's time table.

THURSDAY: REDEMPTION BIBLE STORY: Job Tells of His Redeemer (Job 18:25-27)

- Who redeemed all people? (Romans 3:24)
- Why did Jesus redeem us? (Isaiah 63:9)
- How long does redemption last? (Hebrews 9:12)

FRIDAY'S PSALM: Read PSALM 133. What do think would be a good theme for this chapter?

WEEK 5

MONDAY: WORSHIP BIBLE STORY: Jesus Sets an Example (Luke 4:14-30)

- What are all Christians to do? (Psalm 95:6)
- Who alone is to be worshiped? (Revelation 19:10)
- What should also be the result of our worship? (Luke 24:52)

TUESDAY: BLASPHEMY BIBLE STORY: God's Old Testament Laws (Leviticus 24:10-23)

- Where does the sin of blasphemy originate? (Matthew 15:19)

MONDAY: FAITH BIBLE STORY: The Canaanite Woman's Faith (Matthew 15:21-28)

- What is the definition of faith? (Hebrews 11:1)
- Where does faith originate? (Romans 10:17)
- What must accompany faith? (James 2:17)

TUESDAY: DIVORCE BIBLE STORY: Solomon's Heart Is Torn away from God (1 Kings 11:1-6)

- Who is NOT allowed to separate a marriage? (Matthew 19:6)
- How long does God command marriages to last? (Romans 7:1,2)
- What should be our attitude toward marriage? (Hebrews 13:4)

WEEK 7

MONDAY: IDLENESS BIBLE STORY: Israel's Watchmen Are Lazy (Isaiah 56:9-12)

- What will cause things to go into disrepair? (Ecclesiastes 10:18)
- What can make a man poor? (Proverbs 10:4)
- What good rule is mentioned here? (2 Thessalonians 3:10)

TUESDAY: GOD'S SHEEP BIBLE STORY: Jesus Is the Good Shepherd (John 10)

- What will a good shepherd do for his sheep? (John 10:11)
- What will Jesus do with us, his lambs? (Isaiah 40:11)
- What will we, Jesus' sheep, always want to do? (Psalm 79:13)

FRIDAY'S PSALM: Read PSALM 51. How did David feel after he sinned with Bathsheba?

WEEK 9

MONDAY: STUBBORNNESS

BIBLE STORY: The Stubborn Israelites (1 Samuel 8:6-22)

- To what is stubbornness compared? (Psalm 32:9)
- What is the future of a stubborn and rebellious son? (Deuteronomy 21:18-21)
- How does the Lord feel about the stubborn? (Zechariah 7:11,12)

TUESDAY: DRESS

BIBLE STORY: The Lord Declares Judgment (Isaiah 3:16-26)

- With what should the Christian be clothed? (1 Timothy 2:9,10)
- What is more important than clothes? (Matthew 6:25)
- Where can the Christian's true beauty be found? (1 Peter 3:3,4)

BIBLE STORY: Busybodies in the Congregation at Thessalonica (2 Thessalonians 3:11,12)

- What will trustworthy people hate? (Exodus 18:21)

TUESDAY: FILTHINESS

BIBLE STORY: Lot Is Rescued from a Filthy Society (2 Peter 2:4-10)

- What does James tell us to do with filthiness? (James 1:21)
- What are we to do with filthy language? (Colossians 3:8)
- What is out of place for the Christian? (Ephesians 5:4)

WEDNESDAY'S FAMOUS CHAPTER: Read Acts 7. Enjoy Stephen's beautiful speech and witness.

- How strongly does the Lord feel about cursing? (Exodus 21:17)
- What five things are in the mouths of the wicked? (Psalm 10:7)
- What should not be? (James 3:9,10)
